Punjabi University, Patiala, has been sanctioned an Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Chair by the Department of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Industry and Commerce, under the "Scheme for Pedagogy and Research in IPR for Holistic Education and Academia" (SPRIHA).

This initiative positions the university as the first in the state to establish such a chair, underscoring its commitment to advancing research, training, and awareness in the field of intellectual property rights. The IPR Chair aims to foster innovation and protect intellectual assets by organizing workshops, seminars, and special lectures, thereby creating a robust ecosystem for intellectual property education and technology transfer.
