Workshop on Literary Translation

Applications are invited for a Six-Day Intensive Workshop on Literary Translation from 14th to 19th November 2022 being organised by National Translation Mission, CIIL, Mysuru and the Department of English, Punjabi University, Patiala.

The proposed workshop on translation is intended to train participants through a focused six-day hands-on programme.

The Department of English, Punjabi University is actively engaged in translation of significant works between Punjabi, Hindi and English. Literature in Translation is among the courses being taught at both Master's and Doctoral levels. The Department of English is committed to the long-term goals of decolonisation and Indianisation, modernisation practices, course content pedagogical academic and discourse. It sees itself as a pioneer in building between literatures of the world and those of particularly of Punjab. The pursuit of translation, it is expected, will significantly advance these goals and further aid in the promotion of comparative critical studies.

The Workshop aims at building the necessary competence for quality translation, including that in the realm of knowledge texts of scientific/technical importance. It will open new avenues for employment in view of the emerging expansion of readership of translated works between Punjabi and English. The Workshop will also help to develop new courses of study for the future and will provide meaningful insights for designing research proposals in Translation and Comparative Studies.

- There is no upper age limit for participants.
- The applications will be scrutinized by a screening committee whose decision will be final.
- Interested applicants may note that their progress will be monitored through translation assignments.

- The names of selected applicants will be posted on the website of Punjabi University and displayed on the notice board of the Department of English. Applicants are requested to regularly check the same for updates.
- Lunch and tea will be provided.
