

The paper and its summary in Punjabi should be sent in Asees or Gurmukhi 020 and in font size 12. The paper and its summary should be sent to the undersigned by 31 January 2018 along with CD. The delegation fee is Rs. 700 only and it will be collected (in cash) on the 23 February, 2018. You will be our guest during the period of the Conference. Please inform us about your participation at the earliest. Any further enquiry will be appreciated.**
