I would like to give advice to juniors regarding the selection procedure of newgen. As I have experienced the aptitude part was quite simple, you just need to go through the basic topics like time distance speed question and some blood relation questions. After aptitude test, there was technical written test, I feel it a little bit difficult. Try to solve the pointers questions in C and complexity questions of ADA. Then comes the psychometric test, the simple approach to solve this is that don't skip any question and stay with the answer you firstly marked till the end. And regarding technical interview you just need to learn the basic concepts of C, C++ and database (usage of SQL queries like 'group by' and joins). The H.R. round was quite simple, some questions regarding your personal life and a situation based question.
