The Second question in Section A, the candidates may be asked to translate a paragraph of 80-100 words or ten sentences taken from the text in to Urdu or Punjabi alternatively Second Question caring 10 marks.
- 4. In Section B one question carrying 20 marks may be asked on theme or content of a poem which should have two portions the candidate will attempt one, In the other question carrying 20 marks the candidates may be asked to explain with reference to the context two out of four extracts of 3-4 lines.
- 5. In Section C one question carrying 20 marks should be of an objective type in which the candidates will be asked to attempt 10 out of 15 objective/short answer type questions which will cover both the sections A and B equally each carrying two marks

- 6. Questions should not be vague and wording should be simple.

While in Section D, the candidate should be asked to attempt one out of two. In Section E the candidates should be asked to translate a short passage of Persian into Urdu/Punjabi. In Section F the candidate should be asked to translate a short passage of about 80-100 words or ten simple sentences in Urdu/Punjabi to Persian. In Section A and B question should be on the life and work of Poets only. In Section C candidate should be asked to write a short note on two of the prescribed books out of three. Section D should be asked to a short note.
